Prezi in the Class!

Prezi in another form of PowerPoint. This presentation format offers creative freedom for students to show what they know.

Just like PowerPoint, each student can be responsible for one part so there is accountability for everyone.

Allow students at least one day to explore and learn the Prezi system. This will cut down on frustrated students (and parents).

Use Prezi as a formative or informative assessment, unit project, concept project or even vocabulary!

Below are a few ways to use Prezi.

- 1. Vocabulary.
  - a. Have students in groups of 4.
  - b. All students get ONE vocabulary word.
  - c. Each group works together on a PREZI that will have their 4 words.
  - d. Students present their Prezi.
  - e. Students can copy down the definitions OR you can have it all electronic and students can review ALL vocabulary words on their own.
- 2. Informative assessment
  - a. Divide students into groups of 4 or 5.
  - b. Each student is responsible for ONE concept in a Prezi.
  - c. Students present their Prezi and others can view it online in order to study. (No lost notes) Students can also download Prezi if they do not have the means to view it online.
  - d. For example: Force and Motion: Group 1- What is force?
    Group 2- What is motion? Group 3- Equations
    Group 4- Isaac Newton Group 5- Examples of motion/Examples of force
- 3. Formative assessment
  - a. Students complete their own Prezi with the above information.
